Modify the policies and procedures for your single use as a charity (though we do encourage you to take our Administrator/Leader course to gain the greatest benefit from the manual)	Share the manual with other churches, charities or organizations. Put your policies or our training materials on a website*
Photocopy pages for your different departments	Share your policies with other organizations
